Carlos Fighetti has been involved in orchids for over forty years. He was the founding President of the International Phalaenopsis Alliance and is the current President of the organization. He was president of the American Orchid Society, and was on the Board of Trustees of that organization for fourteen years, five years as a trustee, four years as the vice-president, three years as the president and two as the past president. He has been a member and has chaired several committees of the AOS.

He is a member and a past president of the Greater New York Orchid Society, where he also served for eight years as show Chair of the New York International Orchid Show. In addition, he is a member and was a trustee of the Ramapo Orchid Society in New Jersey, He is the past president of the Puerto Rico Orchid Society, and a member of the Mayaguez, Orquidistas del Sur and Orquidistas de Borinquen Orchid Societies in Puerto Rico. He is also a member of the Pleurothallid Alliance, and the Peruvian and Chilean Orchid Societies

He is an accredited AOS judge, and presently chairs the Puerto Rico Judging Center. He has among his judging, four World Orchid Conferences, the Tokyo Grand Prix Orchid Show, The Taiwan International Orchid Show and several Latin American Shows. He has lectured about orchids all over the US and Canada and at many international venues.

Carlos lives in Guaynabo, Puerto Rico, where he grows approximately 2,500 orchid plants. He grows a mixed collection, including a good number of species. A grower of note, his plants have received over 150 awards from the AOS for horticultural, flower quality and cultural merits, including four FCCs and one CCE. He has also received eight AOS show trophies and many other awards for exhibits at orchid shows around the country.

Professionally, Carlos retired as a Senior Research Associate of the Engineering School at Columbia University, where he was the Director of a well-known research laboratory working on nuclear reactor safety. "The main emphasis was in determining the integrity of the reactor cores and the meltdown levels for normal operating as well as accident conditions for just about every nuclear reactor in the world, including the Russian designs.

Show and has grown substantially in size and prestige from its beginning that today it is considered one of the largest orchid shows in the world competing only with the Japan Grand Prix Orchid Show in Japan.

Attendance for the show is in the order of 250,000 people for the 10-day event. It is staged by the Taiwan Orchid Growers Association (TOGA) and has three levels of judging: Ribbon judging culminating in the selection of a grand champion, TOGA medal judging and AOS judging. AOS has been present since the inception of the show in 2005 and is the event where most AOS awards are given annually, possible averaging 100 AOS awards every year. The show is staged inside large greenhouses with a two acre foot print and a 40-foot ceiling. It consist of several sections: one for large commercial and society exhibits, one for small table top exhibits, a section for individual plants to be considered for ribbons, medals and AOS awards and a large vending area for about 50 commercial vendors of plants and orchid material.

Since Taiwan is the world's supplier of Phalaenopsis for the pot plant industry, a good number of the plants exhibited are Phalaenopsis.

However, they also have superb growers of Paphiopedilum, Cattleya, and Dendrobium growers which also exhibit incredible plants.

The presentation to the San Francisco Orchid society will include all of the sections describes above and also show some of the individual plants enters for ribbon and award competition.

Minutes of the SFOS Board Meeting

SFOS Board Meeting July 17, 2014

Present: George McRae, Mary Gerritsen, Valerie Mountain, Dave Hermeyer, Chris Mende, Carol Zoltowski, Dexter Hodes. Tom Perlite also joined the meeting at the beginning for the POE discussion.

The meeting started at 7:30.

I. POE

A. Tom Perlite joined the meeting to discuss his contract for POE Production manager and give the POE update. A partial payment of \$16,000 is needed now for rent for the Festival Pavilion. The total payment will be approximately \$50,000, which is about 20% higher than last year. The POE committee also looked at the Herbst Pavilion, which is less expensive, but the space is 30% smaller and it will not be available after 2015. The decision was made to stay at the Festival Pavilion for 2015. The admission fee will be increased to \$15, and vendor fees will also be increased. Frances is encouraging Taiwan to sign on as a sponsor as soon as possible so they can be included on the publicity for the show. Tom is starting to send out the vendor contracts.

OITP is volunteers for all positions to staff the show. There has been almost
no response to the sign- up sheets at the last 2 monthly meetings. This could
affect the show being put on next year, as Mary does not wish to run the
show again with the poor response from the membership. This show
generates a large part of the income for the SFOS budget. Please consider
volunteering.

boxes for storage. She will compile a list of all the contents to be kept on file.


