### **VI. Conservation Committee**

A. The SFOS Conservation Committee met on November 5, 2014 to discuss 2 funding requests. The first application was from a Mr. Pradhan from Nepal, titled "Effective education and outreach program for ecology and conservation of threatened orchids in Godavari-Phulchowki mountain forest, Kathmandu Nepal" for the amount of \$2450. This application was approved by the Committee, pending a request for further information. A motion was made by Carol and Florence to fund this proposal from money designated as conservation funds. This motion was passed. The Conservation Committee also discussed the request from the preserve in Ecuador and decided not to pay for this out of their funds. They would like the SFOS to fund this request for \$3000. Since a motion to do this was already passed in June 2014, the SFOS will go ahead and fulfill this with money from General Funds, under the line item in the budget for donations.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:00.

#### **A Note from the Treasurer about Reimbursement**

This is a general reminder about how to request reimbursement for expenses incurred on behalf of the SFOS in order to support the meetings, the Orchids in the Park, the Pacific Orchid Exposition or any other activity that is sponsored by the Society.

There are many SFOS members who do a fabulous job working behind the scenes to obtain equipment, materials and the like that

are vitally important for the success of the society sponsored shows and activities.

This is just a reminder that if you need reimbursement for an expense you must submit an invoice to me, the treasurer so I can write you a check. Make sure the invoice states what the reimbursement is for and your name and address. We track and record each expense in specific categories so this information is very important. If I don't have an invoice, I can't issue the check. It is important that we practice good accounting principles in the event that we are ever audited by federal or state officials. If the expense is something that a SFOS member purchases who is not a Board member or a member of the POE show committee, the request for payment must be approved/signed by a member of the Board or the POE committee, before it is incurred.

As far as shows go, 2014 was a good year. We were all very diligent about the budget and what was spent when. So to make sure that we do as well or better in 2015, please collect invoices. I do my best to issue checks promptly. You can either give the invoices to me in person at the meetings or send them to me. My address is 285 Humboldt Road, Brisbane, Ca. 94005. ### Spring 2015 – ORCHIDS OF THAILAND



Peter Williams of Mae Tang Tours has put together an itinerary covering temples, markets, orchid farms, wildlife sanctuaries, and mountain excursions into an amazing trip proposal. Dates of the trip are March 20 to April 4, 2015. The cost of the trip is \$2250 per person double occupancy, \$2850 per person single occupancy, not including air fare to Thailand. A maximum of 14 persons will be accommodated on this trip, so book early. This trip will be led by OCA director Mary Gerritsen.

### Summer 2015 – BOTANICAL ILLUSTRATION ON THE BRAZILIAN AMAZON

Dulce Nascimento is a Brazilian botanical artist living in Rio who also teaches botanical illustration. Some of you have seen and purchased her work in the OCA booth at orchid shows. She and American print artist and illustrator Kathi McCord will be leading a trip on the Amazon riverboat 'Otter'. The trip will run from June 3rd to June 12th, 2015 and originates in Manaus. Cost is \$2150 for double occupancy and \$2950 for single occupancy, not including airfare to Manaus. The trip is limited to 14 passengers. More details of the itinerary will be available in October. This trip will be led by OCA president, Peter Tobias.

1. **Order timing:** We ask for the order confirmation as soon as possible. The latest is **10th December 2014**. The reason is the

cypripedium seedlings growing in our high mountain nursery and need to be taken out before the soil gets frozen.

**2. How to order:** Please refer the PDF price list file, before you place an order. Please write to [sales@hengduanbiotech.com](mailto:sales@hengduanbiotech.com), or [info@hengduanbiotech.com](mailto:info@hengduanbiotech.com) for confirming availability, price and postage cost.

**3. How to pay:** We receive your payment via money transference to our bank in Euro in Germany, or in US\$ via our PayPal account [sales@hengduanbiotech.com](mailto:sales@hengduanbiotech.com), please notice that we do not share the bank transfer commission and if you pay by PayPal, please add 3% commission fee, as PayPal China charges us commissions and we share the cost with our customers.

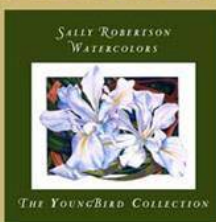
