Steve Beckendorf

Steve started growing orchids in the early 1980s and quickly became fascinated by Odontoglossums and their close relatives because of their beauty and variety. They had a glamorous past as the most sought after plants in the orchid frenzy that gripped Europe in the 19th century. In addition, excellent hybrids were available from growers and hybridizers on the West Coast.

He soon realized that few of the species in this group were readily available and began collecting them for propagation and use in

hybridizing. His attempt to find unusual or lost species has led to many trips to the cloud forests of Mexico & South America.

As a geneticist and developmental biologist at the University of California, Berkeley, Steve has worked on the mechanisms that define tissues and organs in early animal embryos. Because of this background, he has been interested in several of the scientific aspects of orchids, including molecular taxonomy and deceptive pollination strategies.

Steve is passionately involved in orchid conservation and is a director of the Orchid Conservation Alliance (OCA) and a member of the Conservation Committee of American Orchid Society.

For the last five years I've had the opportunity of traveling to Peru with a couple of friends, Guido Deburghgraeve and Stig Dalström, to find and collect orchids that would help document and expand the tremendous diversity of orchids in this huge and underexplored country. We have been able to collect plants because Manolo Arias of Peruflora had gotten permits from the Peruvian environmental authority, Inrena. They asked me to join them.

We traveled to places in both northern and southern Peru where we thought few people had been to collect or identify orchids. We found several new species, some of them large and showy, and enjoyed the spectacular scenery, rare birds like the Andean condor, and wild **Chuck Chan**

Minutes of the SFOS Board Meeting

SFOS Board Meeting- January 12, 2015

Present: George McRae, Jean Lee, Valerie Mountain, Steve Beckendorf, Carol Zoltowski, Tom Perlite, Chris Mende, Claire Zvanski, Dexter Hodes

Excused: Dennis Westler, Florence Inserto, Dave Hermeyer The meeting started at 7:30.

I. President's Report

A. George has asked Chris Mende, Dave Hermeyer and Greg Farley to serve as the nominating committee for SFOS Board Members for the next term, starting in June 2015. Jean Lee expressed interest in replacing Mary Gerritsen as Past President Ex- Officio. Steve made a motion to accept Jean's offer; the motion was passed. Tom, with the help of his brother, Paul, looked into a new insurance policy for the SFOS. They selected an umbrella policy for non- profits, that will cover the SFOS monthly meetings, POE, OITP and board meetings. The policy went into effect at the beginning of January, and will replace the AOS policy. There was some difficulty getting into the Hall of Flowers building for the January monthly meeting. George will look into getting a key for access.

II. Vice President's Report

A. Steve will be the speaker for the February meeting, topic: his recent trip to Peru. Cindy Hill will run the Skill Session, topic: how to enter plants for POE. Plant Opportunity Table is TBD.

III. Treasurer

B. Carol: Checking: \$31,671.76, High Yield Savings: \$117,584.17, Market Rate Savings: \$1506.98.

A comparison of operating finances between 2013 and 2014 was reviewed, and it was noted the society needs about \$28,000 to operate. This does not include POE costs. With a profit of approximately \$40,000 from the 2014 POE, there is some cushion, but expenses still need to be carefully monitored. Carol is ordering credit card machines from Wells Fargo for the POE. Linda Tripp and Jeff Harris, Show Treasurer, will be working with Carol during the POE.

IV. POE

A. Dennis sent in his report, noting that Volunteer Match should be operational on the website this week. Dennis is looking for people to run daily demonstrations on potting and mounting orchids, because

the past speaker, Brian, is not available. There are 3 demonstrations per day, and the pay is \$100/day. There is a sound system provided. Post cards have been mailed, and there has already been an ad/ notice in the SF Chronicle. Because Frances was unable to be at the January monthly meeting, she has asked our poster distribution people to get out more flyers than we usually give them. Flyers, postcards and Tee shirts will be available at the February meeting. Taiwan has signed on for \$27,000, and ads will go up on BART trains and stations.

Tom reported that all vendors have paid except one who will pay upon arrival. Some new exhibitors have signed on for this year. Mary Nesbitt will not be coming this year. Taiwan will have a trade show type exhibit with some focus on orchids. Tom has been working with the Fire Marshall to cover all issues for the show. There is a new regulation requiring Crowd Control Managers for every 250 attendees. This requires a \$20 online course. Tom will provide the link to the board for the course. Floor plans for the show, as now required, are being prepared by a graphic designer. Mark Sullivan will have limited availability to cover Ticket Sales, due to family issues, and would appreciate support from SFOS members.

V. Membership

A. Claire notes that many people renewed their membership at the January meeting, and members were asking about volunteering for the POE. Claire and Florence are getting the Business section of the roster updated due to response to the notice in the January newsletter.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:20.

POE 2015 Member Plant Sales

Information for SFOS Members Who Want to Sell Plants

- 1. Each SFOS member will be permitted to have 100 plants only in the Member Plant Sales area at a time. That means that as your individual plants are sold, you can bring in more. Each night I will make a tally of those plants sold and make that information available to anyone who wants to call me about it.
- 2. Place a label on each plant and make 2 inventory sheets-one for your records and one to give to the chair/sales staff for record keeping.
- 3. Labels must be <u>legible</u> and that includes the price. Member codes will be 3 letters followed by 1 to 3 numbers. At the time of check-in, your chosen letter code will be checked to insure that there are no duplicate codes. Before being placed on the sales table, plants must be checked in by a SFOS Member Plant Sales volunteer. The volunteer staff is responsible for removing any plants that are diseased or not established. A good rule of thumb is, if you would like to buy the plant, then it is good to sell to someone else.
- 4. Plants can be checked in for sale starting Thursday morning **February 19 from 10 AM until 6PM**. <u>Please do not leave your plants without official check-in.</u> If you 'drop plants off' without check in we won't put them on the bench for sale.
- 5. The San Francisco Orchid Society will assume a 25% commission for the sale of plants at the table.
- 6. Each person bringing plants to sell must work at the plant sales table for at least 3 hours-it doesn't have to be all at one time. I do know that the POE is a huge undertaking and there are many people who do lots of volunteer time in a variety of areas. BUT...there are lots of plants in the member plant area and just a few loyal folks who sell everyone's plants year after year. If you are busy doing other things, you must find someone to take your shift obligation. And that shift obligation will have to be at a time where there is a need.
- 7. When you work at the sales area, your purpose is to sell EVERYONE's plants, not just your own plants. Anyone who attempts to sell his or her individual plants without going through the show plant sales procedure will be asked to leave the area with their plants. No side deals!
- 8. Each member who brings in plants is completely responsible for any loss to his or her plants. In other words, we do our best to promote and sell plants and to safeguard them from loss, theft or damage. But it happens.
- 9. Plants can be removed from the plant sales area on Sunday beginning at 15 minutes before the close of the show. Any exception to this must be cleared with the chair or co-chair of the Member Plant Sales area.
- 10. There will be no 'saving' plants [removing plants from the general sales table] for anyone other than those folks who are working in the plant sales area at the time of their shift.
- 11. No plants will be sold at the Member Plant Sales area **BEFORE 4 PM on Thursday, February 19**. There will be no exceptions. No one can put plants behind the sales table for later purchase. We try to keep the sales area a 'level playing field' where everyone gets an

equal crack at the bargains that are there. Sales at that time, before the opening of the show, will be for exact amount cash or check only.

Volunteers are needed for all shifts on all days especially Friday all day, Saturday all day, and Sunday AM! Sunday PM shifts are always overbooked. It will be first come, first served for volunteers for Preview Night until all shifts are filled. Signup sheets will be available at the February SFOS meeting or you can contact me at czoltowski@sbcglobal.net or 415-657-3222. Hope to see you in the member Plant Sales area of the POE.






