A Florida Master Gardener, Guillermo has worked for several years as a professional Landscape Designer in private, municipal and governmental capacities in the South Florida area. He currently works as a private landscape designer & consultant, adjunct faculty for the Landscape Technology Department for Miami Dade College & Landscape Superintendent for City of Miami Lakes. His work entails teaching people how to design a garden successfully with the use of adequate plants and orchids to create functional & environmentally conscious environment. He has published several articles on home gardening, design and orchid articles for South Florida and international magazines. In his spare time, Guillermo is a breeder of pedigree Persian and Himalayan cats, enjoys gardening & exploring tropical regions of the world.

Minutes of the SFOS Board Meeting

SFOS Board Meeting- August 11, 2015

Present: Dave Hermeyer, Valerie Mountain, Jack Ryder, Claire Zvanski, Dennis Westler, Florence Inserto, Fred Schechter, Tom Perlite, Mary Gerritsen, Jean Lee
Excused: Dexter Hodes, Chris Mende
The meeting started at 7:30.

I. Treasurer

A. Jack: Checking: \$16,528.68, High Yield Savings: \$148,580.30, Market Rate Savings: \$1,507.24. The net income for OITP was \$6,494 to date. However, there are a few expenses to be confirmed, such as the exact cost for the SF Chronicle ads, book sales and Tee shirt sales. Jack is working with Beverly on getting all the budget categories straightened out and set up in Quickbooks. He has set up the budget for Fiscal Year 2015, which was reviewed and discussed. There were a few modifications requested. Mary made a motion to accept the budget as modified, the motion was seconded and passed.

II. Vice President

A. Mary for Lauren: The speaker for the September meeting will be Guillermo Salazar, topic Orchids of El Salvador. Chris Mende of Tiny Jungle Orchids will provide the Opportunity Table. In lieu of the Skill Session, there will be an operational meeting at 7:00 open to all members to discuss SFOS issues. Mary will be posting an agenda for the meeting in the newsletter. IV. POE

A. Tom & Dennis: Vendor application packets have been sent out, and some have been received back. The deadline for these is September 1st, with the final payment due October 1st. An agreement has been reached with Belcampo Meats for the catering for food, wine and beer. The coffee and ice cream vendors are also set, with all food & drink vendors paying fees this year. Taiwan has still not committed as sponsor. The next POE meeting will be September 26th at Maureen Clarke's house; please call her if attending. The theme for POE is "The Legacy of Orchids", focusing on the history of cultivation, taxonomy and illustration. There will be an art display wall provided by Arader Gallery. Dennis is also contacting another artist about painting watercolors of display plants during the show. Sally Robertson and another artist are being considered for the poster. There will not be a Gala this year, and there may be some corporate parties on Friday & Saturday nights. Frances has asked Mary to set up the speaker schedule for the weekend. Mary will be asking the Pleurothallid Alliance to be speakers for one day.

V. OITP

A. The overall show went well, busier as usual on Saturday than Sunday. There was a discussion about changing the location of the center display, because it is difficult to keep the public from touching or taking the display plants. No plants were taken this year, but some flower spikes were broken. A suggestion was made to put the display against the wall, but people still need to be able to get close to the plants to photograph them. This will be discussed further for next year. Members will also be notified to bring plants for the display.

VI. New Business

A. Lauren Nguyen has resigned as Vice President. Mary was asked and has accepted to serve until the next election. Dennis made a motion to accept Mary's appointment as Vice President, the motion was seconded and passed.

B. Date for 2016 OITP needs to be reserved as soon as possible. A discussion was held about changing the date to the fall, but there are too many events in the park during those months. The SF marathon was also on Sunday this year, but the race ended in the morning, so it only affected morning attendance and parking. This weekend in July seems to be the best for the show, so Tom advised that we should reserve the date and alert the vendors for next year. Dave made a motion to reserve the last weekend in July for 2016 OITP. The motion was seconded and passed. Dave will

C. Insurance: SFOS currently has \$5,000 of theft and fraud insurance. Tom's brother is proposing to increase this coverage. He is preparing quotes for the higher coverage and this will be discussed further when the rate information is received.

D. POE posters: CAIWest Orchids may be interested in buying the old SFOS posters. Some would be kept for historical reference. Jean noted that we do have an archive of past posters. This would reduce the amount of items in the storage locker. Mary made a motion to sell the posters to CAIWest based on the amount that they offer to pay for them. The motion was seconded and passed. Dave will contact CalWest to follow up.

E. Domain name: Jack proposed purchasing a new domain name: orchidsf.org, in addition to our current domain name (orchidsanfrancisco.org). The cost is nominal, \$7.99 for one year. Dave made a motion to purchase both orchidsf.org and sforchids.org. This was seconded and passed. These names will have to be renewed as needed.

F. Newsletter backup editor: Stanford Stapleton would like to have a backup editor and start training this person as soon as possible. The newsletter is created from a template. Claire proposed asking the membership to see if someone is interested. Dave will make an announcement at the September monthly meeting.

G. Denim shirts as a perk for higher membership levels and/or to sell. Mary has looked into Lands End for the shirts. There is a \$90 set up fee for the logo plus a fee for each shirt. Frances has used other vendors for the POE shirts. Discussion was held about doing more expensive items for the membership perks and POE logo denim shirts for all members to buy. Jack proposed doing Tee shirts with American Apparel, which is a local company. Mary proposed that that board look at the various vendors and their products to see what is available. This will be discussed further at next month's board meeting.

September 1, 2015 meeting "skill session"

SFOS Member's Interactive Meeting Sept 1, 2015 STARTS at 7 PM Promptly

In lieu of the skill session for the September meeting, we will have an interactive discussion with the membership regarding some important pending changes to the SFOS and its activities. This meeting will start at 7 pm in the auditorium.
NOTE: This meeting will be limited to 30 minutes so that the regular meeting can start on time. The SFOS board members will be on hand for this discussion.

Topics include:

1. Downsizing of the Storage Locker. Our storage fees keep going up, and are now approaching \$6000/yr, the single largest expense of the society. Our plan is to reduce the volume of storage and to transfer to a smaller locker about 1/2 the size of the

current one and to reduce this cost by about 50%. Suggested modifications include:

- o Sale of SFOS Posters
- o Donating or otherwise eliminating the wool table cloths
- o Donating, recycling or selling other miscellaneous items in the storage locker

- o There will be no Gala for the POE in 2016.

3. December Meeting

- o We will have a Holiday Pot-Luck Dinner for our December meeting as we did last year. Suggestions from members welcome.

Holger Perner and Wenqing Perner from [Hengduan Mountains Biotechnology Ltd. China](#) will visit California at the beginning of *October 2015* and bring over orchid flasks and orchids.


