

cost of the storage locker, which is currently more than \$6000/year. These include renting a smaller size locker and reducing the inventory currently held in the locker. Ellen noted, as property manager for the Society, that she has certain requirements for the locker to be convenient for her to load and unload the items for POE and OITP. These include being close to her home and to Enterprise for the van rental, a 1st floor drive up location, a roll up door, electricity, being weatherproof, late evening hours, and large enough for all the items to be stored. She has researched the other storage locations in the area, and found the current location to be the best option. Dave & Tom have found that there are smaller lockers at this location for about half the cost of the current locker. In order to fit the smaller locker, some non-recurring items would need to be temporarily stored elsewhere until POE or disposed of. The table covers will be recycled if possible, Tom will take the cardboard boxes to hold for POE, and Dave will hold the wine glasses at his house. A motion was made to give out 1 wine glass per member at the December Holiday party, and also sell boxes of 6 for \$10. The motion was seconded and passed. Ellen is going to check the availability of the smaller lockers and their locations, and see if there is any discount for 501(c)3 organizations. Once the new locker is found, there may be an overlap for a month or so, as the contents are sorted and moved.

II. Treasurer

B. Jack: Balances as of October 31: Checking \$9,899.36, High Yield Savings \$168603.74, Market Rate Savings \$1,507.35.

There has been a commitment of \$950 for tour groups for the POE.

III. Vice President

A. Dave for Mary: The December meeting will be the Potluck Holiday Party. There will be a Show & Tell Table. January's speaker will be Pierre Pujol, topic: Cymbidium Culture. He will also provide the Opportunity Table. Skill Session TBA.

February's speaker will be Ron Parsons, topic : Adventures in Southeast Australia. Sam Tsui has been rescheduled for the April 2016 meeting, and Peter Lin is scheduled for the May meeting. Mary is traveling in Colombia and will be looking for new speakers while she is there.

IV. Membership

B. Claire: A couple of new members joined at the November monthly meeting, and 2 more through PayPal. Renewals are coming in slowly, and a reminder will be put in the newsletter. The membership forms will be updated with the new membership categories, as well as online. Florence and Claire are working on the updates for the membership brochure.

V. POE

A. Tom's report: We have 46 vendors who have committed/paid for this year. We have collected \$57,958.00 with another \$10,025 outstanding. This includes our food and coffee vendors (\$2300.00) We may also have a coffee truck out front. There are still 6 booths available in the vendor area. McLellan Botanicals is considering being a vendor this year. Lyngso Garden Materials will have a complimentary vendor booth in the back. We have 9 foreign vendors this year: 2 from Ecuador, 2 from Peru, 2 from

Taiwan, 1 from China, 1 from Thailand, 1 from Malaysia. Invitations have been sent out to individual exhibitors and Orchid Societies. So far the Conservatory of Flowers and Orchid Conservation Alliance, Golden Gate Cymbidium Society, Pleurothalid Alliance and Orchid Friends have responded. U.C. Botanical Garden would like an information booth, but cannot install an exhibit or provide plants for the entrance exhibit. Tom has approached the various orchid societies about installing their exhibits in the landscaped area on the west side of the building. So far, only Oakland Orchid Society has shown interest. Sponsors: Metamorphosis Landscaping (free), Bath Fitters (\$1500), Renewal by Anderson (\$2500) Lyngso (free), and Sungevity (\$3500) will have vendor booths in the sales area. S.F. Chronicle may have a truck out in front of the venue (\$2500).

Fort Mason has instituted a new ticket policy, whereby they will collect all tickets, both on line and at the door for all events held at Fort Mason. Since we signed our contract with them prior to the new policy, we are not bound by it this year. We will be for 2017, however. Tom has spoken to the new Box Office Manager and we will be in discussions regarding our ticket fees for future shows, as well as our contract with Event Brite for 2017. Frances and Tom have spoken to Christina Tucker about a possible orchid related video for the show. She has done a number of documentary and informational videos including one on Rod McLellan and the early days of the company. She has proposed to do a 3 minute general video on orchids for \$3000, or a 5 minute video for \$5500 including the history of orchid growing and collecting along with general information. The video would be played continuously on a monitor in the show. The video could be sold at the show and also used in subsequent shows. The board held a discussion and felt the longer length video would be better. Jean made a motion to pursue producing the 5 minute video. The motion was seconded and passed. This will be discussed further at the next POE meeting.

Fred Clarke mentioned how some societies have abandoned the gala evenings and replaced them with photographer nights, where photographers pay a premium for admission into the show on Thursday night in order to photograph the plants without the crowds during the weekend. We would need the sponsorship of a camera company and use their mailing list to attract photographers, in order to cover the \$4000 in rent for the evening. It is too late this year to pursue this, but perhaps something for next year. The board held a discussion, and Jean has some contacts she will check with.

VI. Old Business

A. Denim Shirts: Ten shirts were ordered at the November monthly meeting. Mary is going to try another option for the flower motif: changing the colors to white & green.

B. Insurance: Dave is still working on this.

C. Newsletter Back Up Editor: Fred Schechter has expressed an interest in taking this on, and will be meeting with Stanford.

D. Holiday Party: Mary is putting together a gift table of plants from Bob Hamilton, John Leathers, Sunset Valley Orchids and




